A good reputation enables members to take pride in their organization. Envirothon members have an excellent reputation. Your conduct at any Envirothon function should make a positive contribution to the reputation that has been established.

- Your behavior at all times should be such that it reflects credit to you, your school and the Envirothon program.
- Student conduct is the responsibility of the advisor. Students shall keep their advisors informed of their whereabouts and activities at all times.
- You are expected to attend all scheduled activities. Please be prompt and show respect to those in the audience, at station sites, and on stage.
- Participants are to report any accident, injury or illness to their advisor.
- Participants are expected to observe the designated curfew, at overnight events.
- If a student is responsible for stealing, vandalism, fighting, or having weapons, the student will be disqualified and his/her parents will be expected to pay all damages.
- Participants attending the Georgia Envirothon may not purchase, consume, or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any time. Violators will be subject to disciplinary or legal action.
- Smoking & all tobacco products are strictly prohibited.
- The Georgia Envirothon and its participants operate on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, marital status or physical/mental challenges.
